

## **REC Program Allies**

The Recreation Energy Conservation ("REC") program helps municipally-owned recreation facilities reduce energy use and greenhouse gas emissions (GHGs) by providing rebates to help identify energy-saving opportunities and implement energy-saving projects. Through REC, municipalities can receive rebates for Scoping Audits and Engineering Studies that support investment decisions in addition to Implementation Project rebates for implementing energy efficiency retrofits.

Program Allies are professional firms with the ability to deliver Scoping Audits and Engineering Studies through the REC program. Program Allies can help participating municipalities identify and quantify energy-saving opportunities in their facilities that can be acted upon through an Implementation Project. Municipalities are invited to contact a Program Ally from the following list for quotes to complete a Scoping Audit or Engineering Study through the REC program. Municipalities must include the quote information in their application and sign an Offer Letter before funding is reserved for the project and work can begin.
