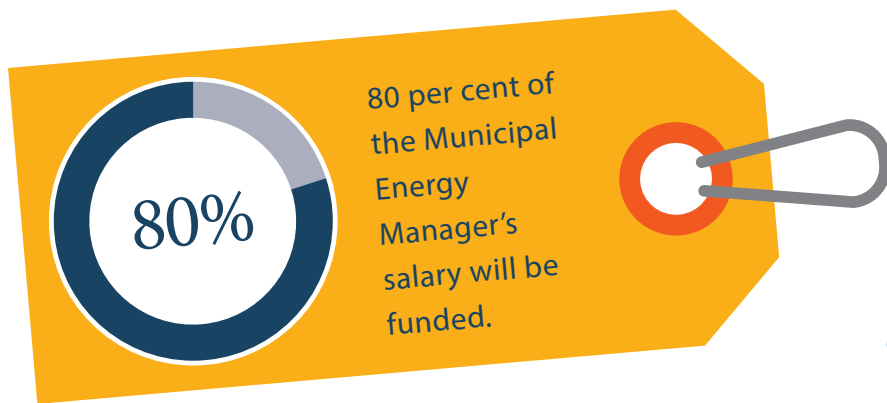
Municipal Energy Manager Program



Manage energy use with a Municipal Energy Manager. A Municipal Energy Manager helps Alberta municipalities manage energy, implement energy-saving projects, and reduce costs for their facilities. Funding is available to supplement the salary of a new or existing municipal employee to serve as the Municipal Energy Manager.



PROGRAM FUNDING



GOAL

The Municipal Energy Manager (MEM) program, administered by the Municipal Climate Change Action Centre, helps municipalities generate or refresh an energy management plan, assess energy management practices, identify energy saving opportunities, and implement energy saving and GHG reducing projects.

DID YOU KNOW?

All designated municipalities within the province of Alberta are eligible to participate in the MEM program that have a population size below 150,000 residents. Small municipalities are encouraged to partner with one or more neighbouring municipalities to share a staff member across their region.

HOW TO APPLY

Submit a MEM Expression of Interest after reviewing the program details. Municipalities must describe their current energy management capabilities and their need for energy management support. Learn more at mccac.ca/programs/MEM. Request or register for a webinar.
